Hello Fellow Travelers.

On one of my drives into the office recently I heard a song on the radio. It was written in 2016, but I had not yet heard it. The song is *Kill a Word*, written by Charles Lucas Ian Dick, Eric Church, and Jeff Hyde. Sung by Eric Church. *Kill a Word*.

Through the lyrics, some of the words that he would like to kill are: goodbye, regret, fear, hate, brokenness and heartbreak, upset, and disgrace.

The song goes on to say that he would rather take the sticks and stones and be black and blue because words do hurt. You can't unhear, you can't unsay the words. He would turn lies and hate to love and truth.

Over the past month we have been working our way through the latter chapters of the gospel of Matthew. These are parables that we have known for a long time, and would much rather read from Luke, which is gentler. Matthew's stories through chapters 22 and 23 are aggressive. There is a lot of killing and violence, throwing people into the outer darkness, gnashing of teeth and wailing.

Please, don't give up on the parables in Matthew's telling. These readings are important because by the end of the story, Jesus is talking of God's love. God is not vengeful.

Jesus has been telling us for a very long time to give up on the words of hate. Jesus tells us over and over again that there is healing for regret, brokenness, and disgrace. Jesus calls us to be part of the story of reconciliation and healing. We are called to continue the work, using the words of love, that Jesus taught us.

As we move into Advent, and we think of the gifts that we can give, think of the way our words can offer gifts. Gifts that cost nothing out of pocket. Gifts of healing and care. Gifts of love and truth.







# fun facts from the archivesi

Even though we were organized in the summer of 1860, the people met for two years in the Bailey's home.

We were founded as a Christian Colony and College based upon the general plan of Oberlin Colony and College. The church was part of the Academy.

From the Bailey's home, onto the log schoolhouse, then we moved to the upper floor of the college in 1867.

The building that is now the Historical Museum was completed and dedicated as the First Congregational Church of Benzonia in 1887.

We helped with the Underground Railroad, helping people reach Canada.

For more information on the growth of the church and the county check out Rev. Harlow Mills book, <u>The Making of a Country Parish</u>. It is a fascinating read and in both our library and the Benzonia Public Library.

The Mills Community House was once part of the church campus.

We joined the United Church of Christ in 1961.

The building that now is the home of First Congregational Church of Benzonia, United Church of Christ, was dedicated in April 1968.

We are a church with a mission to welcome all people into being followers of Jesus Christ, to serve our community, and to nourish and enrich our faith. Our vision is to be a united community in Christ's love.
