

Hello,

We are moving closer to the end of the year and the time that I set out as place to try new things. I hope that you stretched a bit and tried some of the options for contemplative practice.

I think that with Thanksgiving coming in just a few weeks, and many of us being with family and friends, that we take a look at the practice of dialogue and deep listening. Two things that should always go hand in hand.

In our fast-moving world, conversation often becomes a race — to be heard, to make a point, to respond quickly. But in the life of faith, when we are faithful, dialogue and deep listening can become sacred, contemplative acts.

True dialogue is more than exchanging opinions. The word itself, from the Greek <u>dia</u> (through) and <u>logos</u> (word, meaning, truth), reminds us that something holy passes *through* our words when we speak with openness and listen with love. In dialogue, we don't try to win; we try to understand. We trust that God's Spirit may be speaking through another's story as much as through our own.

Deep listening is the heart of this practice. It asks us to quiet our inner chatter and simply be present. To listen without planning our reply, without judgment, without hurry. Thomas Merton once wrote of listening as "hearing the divine heartbeat in all things." When we listen this way — to one another, to creation, to God — we are doing more than a contemplative practice, we are practicing in prayer.

We might begin this practice by adding small pauses into our conversations, allowing moments of silence to breathe between words. Try listening for what lies underneath another person's words: longing, fear, gratitude, or hope. We can try to respond with curiosity instead of correction. Perhaps, over time, this kind of listening can become a form of contemplation in community — a way of discovering sacred presence between us.

In dialogue grounded in love and listening shaped by prayer, we find not just understanding, but transformation. Every conversation can become a doorway into the holy. Breathe Deep. Slow our speech. Listen with intent.



We will also be looking for volunteers to deliver cookies on 12/13, 12/14, or 12/15. If you would like to help with this project, please contact Chris Stone.




